Design brief for three rooms

CHECK LIST 2020 – DESIGN CHALLENGE

- Download all paperwork on Rebuild Down Under page
- Read through Notes from the builder
- Read through Notes from the Architect
- Read up on each style of home
- Read up on Merino Homes and what we value
- Look at inspiration houses (details below)

TO BECOME A FINALIST

All entries will be reviewed and judged provided the following is supplied;

- Initial concept boards for all three rooms
- Maximum eight pages
- A letter or video to Katie explaining your vision

Concept Boards are expected to suggest;

- colour /material suggestions
- furnishings/accessories
- lighting and soft furnishings

From there a select few will progress to the finalist round. These finalists will be selected by panel of judges from ISCD and Merino Homes. Finalists will need to present the following;

- Complete Finishes design brief for all three rooms – Maximum four pages
- Complete Furnishing brief for all three rooms – Maximum four pages
- A letter / video to the Judges explaining your vision

- All selections and furnishings must be supplied exclusively by the companies participating in the challenge.
